Pre-med: MD Coursework

- Any major will work!
 - BMS - Anatomy and Physiology concentration sets up classes the best
- Prerequisites:
 - 2 semesters of bio + 1 lab
 - 2 semesters of physics +2 labs (**1 more than BMS reqs**)
 - 2 semesters of general chemistry + 2 labs
 - 2 semesters of organic chemistry + 1 lab (**Group B for BMS**)
 - 2 semesters of math (includes stats and calc)
 - 1 semester of biochemistry
 - 2 semesters of english (includes college comp and advanced writing)

Pre-med: MD Coursework

- Recommended courses:
 - 1 semester of genetics
 - 1 semester of microbiology or environmental health (public health related courses)
 - Non-english language courses
 - 1 semester of psychology or sociology (social science)
 - 1 semester of anatomy and physiology (HIGHLY recommended)

Pre-med: MD Stats

- Research lab hours, experiential hours (shadowing, working in the medical field, volunteering) recommended - NOT required
- MCAT - Medical College Admissions Test
 - Required to apply to US medical schools; scores above 500 (above 50th percentile) preferred
- GPA - Grade Point Average
 - Recommended to have above 3.5 science GPA and above a 3.7 cumulative GPA

Pre-med: PA Coursework

- General course requirements:
 - 2 semesters of general chemistry w lab
 - 2 semesters of biology w lab
 - 1 semester of microbiology w lab
 - 1 semester of anatomy w lab
 - 1 semester of physiology w lab
 - 1 semester of statistics
 - 2 semesters of english
 - 1 semester of psychology

Pre-med: PA Coursework

- Recommended and occasionally required classes
 - 1 semester of physics w lab
 - 1 semester of biochemistry
 - 1 semester of medical terminology
 - 1 semester of genetics
 - 1 semester of organic chemistry
 - 1 semester of sociology (or another humanities course)
 - 1 to 2 semesters of foreign language
 - Additional courses in psychology

Pre-med: PA GPA and GRE

- GPA
 - Most PA programs have a minimum GPA and science GPA requirement between 2.75 and 3.2
 - Overall average GPA of 3.6
- GRE: Graduate Record Examination
 - Average scores:
 - Quantitative (153.1)
 - Verbal (153.7)
 - Writing (4.1)
 - Can be retaken and you can choose which score to send
- Letters of Recommendation
 - 3-5 letters; at least 1 must be from a clinical setting

Pre-med: PA CASPA Experience

- Patient care experience (required!!!)
 - EMT, CNA, phlebotomist, dental hygienist, LVN, RN
 - Required: 500-1000 hours Average: 3300 hours
- Shadowing
 - Average: 215 hours
- Volunteering
 - Average 720 hours
- Research
- Leadership experience
- Teaching experience
- Extracurricular activities
- Non-healthcare employment

Pre-dental Coursework

- Required

- 2 semesters biology with lab
- 2 semesters general chemistry with lab
- 2 semesters organic chemistry with lab
- 2 semesters physics with lab
- 2 semesters english
- 1 semester humanities

- Recommended/sometimes required

- Statistics
- Microbiology
- Anatomy
- Physiology
- Applied art
- Foreign language

Pre-dental: GPA, DAT, extracurriculars

- GPA: > 3.2 preferred
- DAT: Dental Admission Test
 - Survey of the natural sciences: 100 questions on biology and chemistry
 - Perceptual ability: 90 questions on spatial reasoning
 - Reading comprehension: 50 questions on general topics
 - Quantitative reasoning: 40 questions on statistics, algebra, and analysis
- Experience:
 - Job shadow dentists/gain experience
 - Community service
 - Extracurriculars, clubs, leadership
 - Manual dexterity

Pre-nursing: Coursework

- Prerequisites:

- 2 semesters english
- 1 semester anatomy/physiology w/ lab
- 1 semester biology w/ lab
- 1 semester microbiology w/ lab
- 1 semester chemistry w/ lab
- 1 semester nutrition
- 1 semester pharmacology
- 2 semesters psychology

- Recommended:

- Additional semester of anatomy/physiology (micro or macro)
- Medical terminology
- Speech psychology
- Developmental psychology
- Additional semester of pharmacology
- Intro to sociology

Pre-nursing: GPA, Exams

- GPA requirements range between 2.6 and 3.4; average of 3.0
- Multiple exams available
 - Most common: National League for Nursing Pre-Admission Exam (PAX) and Nursing Entrance Exam (NET)
 - Retakes required annually
- Health exams and vaccinations annually

Pre-vet Coursework

- Coursework
 - Depends greatly on desired school
 - Generally the courses needed will be covered by any BMS concentration
 - Although not required, foreign language courses stand out
- GPA
 - Wide range among US schools, 3.2-3.8 overall
 - Some schools look specifically at science GPA
 - CSU (class of 2025): overall average is 3.7; science average is 3.5
- GRE
 - Some schools still require applicants to take the GRE, moving away from it
 - CSU does NOT require it

Pre-vet Experience

- Experience
 - With and Without Veterinarian Supervision
 - With: any in clinic experience or time spent with a veterinarian
 - Without: good to see community involvement
 - Most important is showing you are actually passionate about what you're doing
 - Try to get varied experiences
 - 500 hours is about average
- Involvement
 - Animal related involvement in community and school
 - Look for passion first and foremost
- Skills
 - Like to see demonstrations of communication skills and leadership

Pre-vet Application

- Application
 - Veterinary Medical College Application Service (VMCAS)
 - Some will require supplemental applications
 - Usually 3 letters of recommendation
 - At least one from professor
- Some colleges have altered their requirements for the Spring 2020/Fall 2021 semesters due to CoViD-19
